RBT (Registered Behavior Technician)

HANDS ON ABA LLC has immediate openings for full-time (20-35 hours/week) and part-time (less than 20 hours/week) Registered Behavior Technicians (RBT) positions across Las Vegas to join our team. We are looking for motivated and enthusiastic individuals to provide behavior intervention to children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Our staff works with children in a 1:1 (one on one) setting in home and community settings. Behavior technicians are responsible for implementing Behavior Intervention Plans and skill acquisition goals designed and supervised by a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA).

Any applicant that is hired and is currently seeking their BCBA or BCaBA will be provided with supervision hours with no restrictive contractual agreement.

HANDS ON ABA LLC provides evidence-based therapy through Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA).

Duties

- Implement treatment plans and behavioral procedures under the direction of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA)
- Provide quality 1:1 instruction to children with ASD in communication, social, play and adaptive skills
- Maintain thorough electronic treatment notes on each client by recording objective daily data reflecting progress towards goals
- Professionally interact with co-workers, clients, and families with respect and responsiveness to their needs.
- Maintain confidentiality and professionalism in all work-related environments
- Follow industry guidelines for ethical and professional performance.
- Attend staff meetings and in-service training.
- Implement knowledge of HIPAA and health and safety practices.
- Effectively communicate verbally and in writing with team members and supervisors
- Perform related duties as assigned
- Strong willingness to learn
